

## Roy Dale Jenkins

December 11, 1939 - June 29, 2020

Roy Dale Jenkins, 80, entered Heaven's gates Monday, June 29th, 2020. He was born December 11, 1939 the son of Albert and Eunice (Rigney) Jenkins in Checotah, Oklahoma.

Roy lived most of his life in Muskogee, marrying the love of his life, Nora Margaret (Cox) on November 15, 1963. They were married for 56 years before she preceded him in death in 2019. Roy was a longtime faithful member of Eastern Heights Baptist church, leading his Sunday school class in song, being a part of the financial committee and helping out at the slushee stand back in the day in vacation bible school.

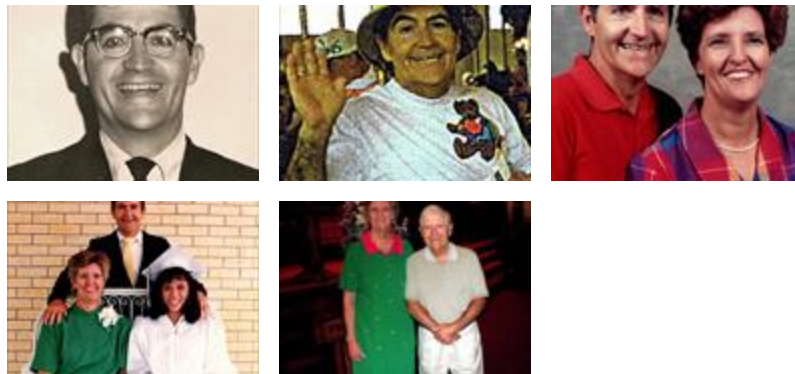
