Sharon Kay Brown Ratterree, 75, was born on December 26, 1945 in Keota, Oklahoma to Hubert and Grace Mae (Whittson) Brown. She went home to the Lord on January 19, 2021. Sharon grew up in Keota and was a graduate of the class of 1964.
