Stephanie Hitt-Guinn, 49, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on Sunday, May 5, 2024. She was born on May 17, 1974 to Michael Alan Hitt and Janna Lou (Allen) Hitt in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Stephanie graduated from Muskogee High School with the class of 1992 and obtained her associate degree from Connors State College. While growing up in Muskogee she participated in dance lessons, playing tennis and fishing.

Stephanie was previously employed at Mike's Affiliated Foods as a retail clerk. She later enjoyed working with Evelyn Hibbs at W.I.S.H. Inc. as a secretary and helping with the support groups there. She was a member of Muskogee First Baptist Church.

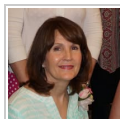
