Steven David Dillon, age 44, of Seattle, Washington, passed away Saturday, October 4, 2025, leaving behind a legacy of compassion, creativity, and dedication. Born December 12, 1980, in Muskogee, Oklahoma to William Ford Dillon Sr. and Janice LaDelle (Foreman) Dillon, Steven's life was marked by achievement, service, and an abiding love for the arts.

At the age of 5, Steven asked Jesus into his heart and was saved at a Captain Hook children's ministry crusade. He graduated from Warner High School in the class of 1999. Known for his academic excellence, he was a proud honor roll student and served as the yearbook editor. His talents extended beyond the classroom, as he performed in "Grease" with the Muskogee Little Theatre, showcasing his passion for dance and performance.

After high school, Steven attended Northeastern State University for two years, where he participated in River City Dance. He then graduated from the University of Central Oklahoma with a bachelor's degree in dance education and was a devoted member of the university's dance company. He had the opportunity to perform at the Kennedy Center. Steven's artistry and dedication led him to tour Europe with the acclaimed Ririe-Woodbury Dance Company out of Salt Lake City, Utah, inspiring audiences abroad with his talent.

Steven spent over a decade as a regional trainer for MAC Cosmetics, where

he was admired for his expertise, mentorship, and vibrant personality. His commitment to community was equally remarkable; he volunteered for several charitable organizations in Seattle and worked at DESC for 6 years as volunteer program assistant and workplace giving specialist, enriching lives with his generosity and kindness until the time of his passing.

Steven will be remembered for his warmth, artistic spirit, and unwavering support for others. His life touched countless friends, colleagues, and family members, and his memory will continue to inspire those who knew him.

One of Steven's dear friends in Seattle described him as the true definition of a star. He shined his light so that others could shine their brightest. Steven was truly loved by so many and will always remain in our hearts.

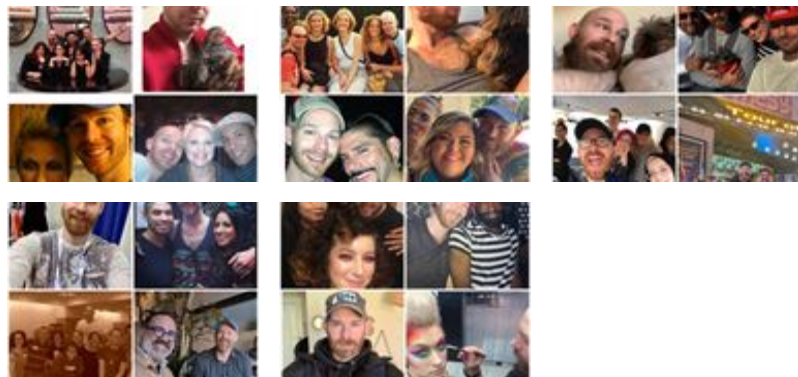
