Sue Lyn Evans, 73, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on Tuesday, July 26, 2022. Sue was born on January 22, 1949 to Col CW McConnell and Jackie McConnell in Stuttgart, Germany. She attended primary school in numerous cities and countries throughout the world due to her father's position in the U.S. Army and graduated from Highland High School in Illinois. She continued her education at the University of Oklahoma where she received a bachelor's degree in Nursing. She also received her master's degree in Nursing from the University of Tulsa. Sue worked as an RN and Administrator at the Veterans Hospital in Muskogee before transitioning into academia as a Nursing instructor at Connors State College in Warner, OK. 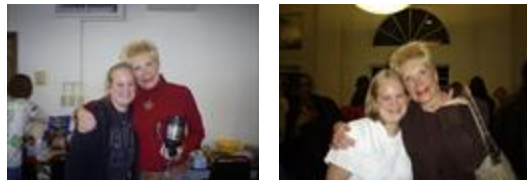

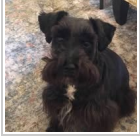

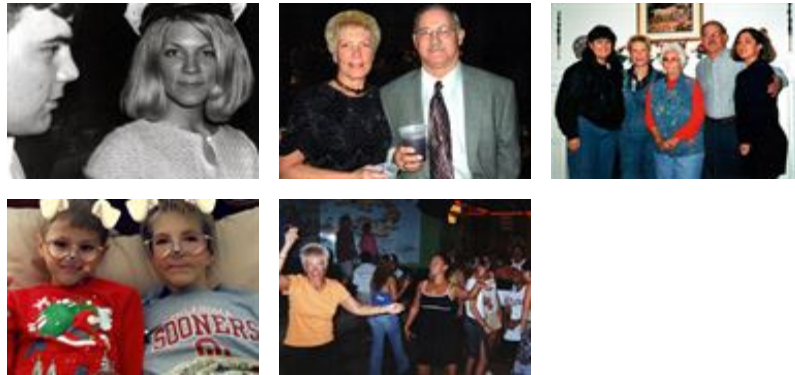
