Terry Lee Majors, 60, passed away Saturday, December 30, 2017. He was born February 21, 1957 in Muskogee, Oklahoma to Forrest and Grace Majors. He was the youngest of 11 children, with 7 brothers and 3 sisters.

In 1967, at 10 years old, he was baptized at Riverside Christian Church. He graduated from Muskogee High School in 1975. He earned a bachelor's degree in business management from Northeastern State University. Upon graduation he worked for Jim Beaver Carpet and Tile in Muskogee. In 1983 he became territory manager for Interstate Supply. His territory stretched from Oklahoma into Kansas, Arkansas, and Missouri. In 1998, to be closer to family, he began working at C&C Carpet and Tile in Tulsa as a flooring estimator and inspector. His career ended in December 2010 when Alzheimer's began to interfere.

Terry was introduced to Julie Boehm by a close friend. Their romance blossomed, and they were married in 1982. Their first son, Eric, was born the following year. They welcomed a daughter, Katie, in 1986 and another son, Ryan in 1992. Terry commuted from work to coach his children's soccer and baseball teams for many years. He was always a devoted father and rarely missed his children's activities.

His hobbies included coaching sports, reading, gardening, working on old trucks, and watching NASCAR races. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and he passed on his love for the outdoors to his children. They enjoyed time together hunting or fishing as a family. He was always a wonderful father that

devoted his later years to his children and grandchildren. He is an example of the kind of parent his children aspire to be. He has been blessed with three grandchildren, Isaac, Ethan, and Alan. He will look forward to the arrival of more from heaven.

He is preceded in death by his parents, four brothers, Paul, Gene, Everette, and Donald as well as several nephews.

He is survived by his children, Eric Majors and partner Melissa Atchley, Katie Pratt and husband Justin, and Ryan Majors and wife Ally; his grandchildren, Isaac, Ethan, Alan with another on the way;

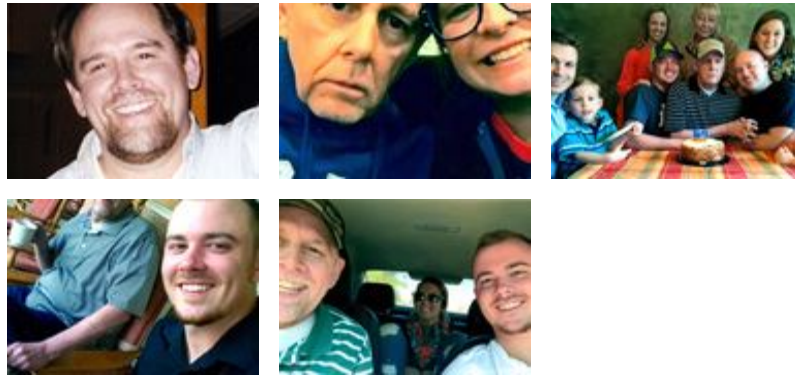
