Thomas “Tommy” Floyd Bebee, Jr., 65, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, February 16, 2019. He was born on March 10, 1953 to Thomas Floyd Bebee Sr. and Dauna (Hayden) Bebee in Muskogee, Oklahoma. He was a lifelong resident of the Muskogee area. Tommy attended Oktaha Public School and graduated with the class of 1971. He loved playing sports and was always an “Oktaha Tiger”. Tommy was a member of the Chandler Road Church of Christ.

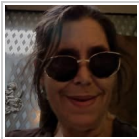

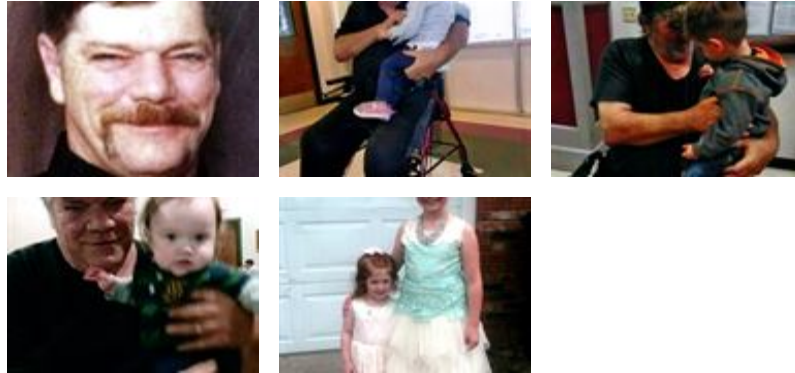
