Thomas Earl "Butch" Caster, 75, of Glenpool, Oklahoma, passed away on January 1, 2025. He was born on June 20, 1950, in Muskogee, Oklahoma, to Earl and Grady Lela (Dennis) Caster.

Butch graduated from Muskogee Central High School in 1968 and went on to study horticulture at Connors State College. He proudly served his country in the United States Army after being drafted and stationed in Germany. Upon returning home, Butch began a long career with the United States Postal Service in Muskogee, from which he retired.

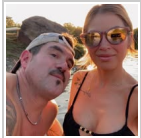
