Thomas attended several private schools in his early years and graduated with a High school diploma from Hilldale High School with Honors, Class of 2011.

He played the trumpet for Hilldale Band, learned drums and loved hanging out with friends during the summers playing video games.

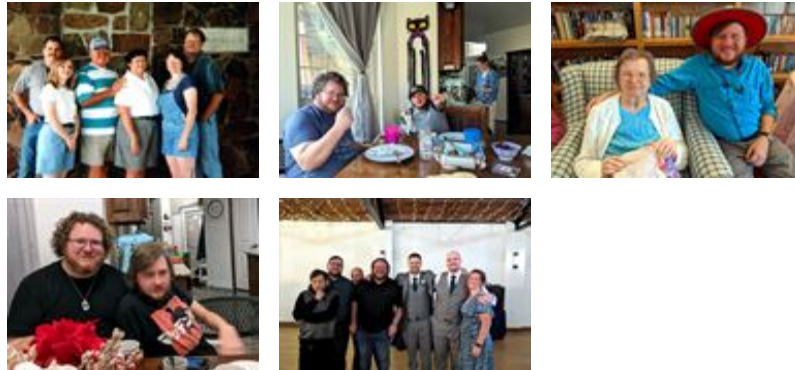
