



Thomas Allen McCarter

February 8, 1932 - April 9, 2022

Thomas 'Tom' Allen McCarter, 90, of Muskogee, OK passed away on Saturday, April 9th, 2022. He was born on February 8th, 1932 to James and Ida (Garrison) McCarter in Muskogee, OK. He attended public school and graduated from Muskogee Central High School in 1950. After graduating Tom joined the United States Army, proudly serving his country during the Korean War.

Tom married the love of his life Dorothy Marie Stockton on September 3, 1954 in Muskogee, OK. They shared 62 years of marriage and memories together. Tom owned and operated a dairy farm south of Muskogee with his father and later a cattle ranch operation. He worked for the United States Postal Service as a rural carrier for 33 years until retiring in 1998.

He was a charter member of Grandview Baptist Church. Tom loved God and his family, especially his grandchildren and great-grandchildren and he loved his church. Tom was also a member of the Bedouin Shrine Temple for 50 years and a member of the Mounted Patrol.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Stockton McCarter; parents, J.W. and Ida McCarter; sisters, Betty McCarter and Joyce Freeman; and brother, Dan McCarter.

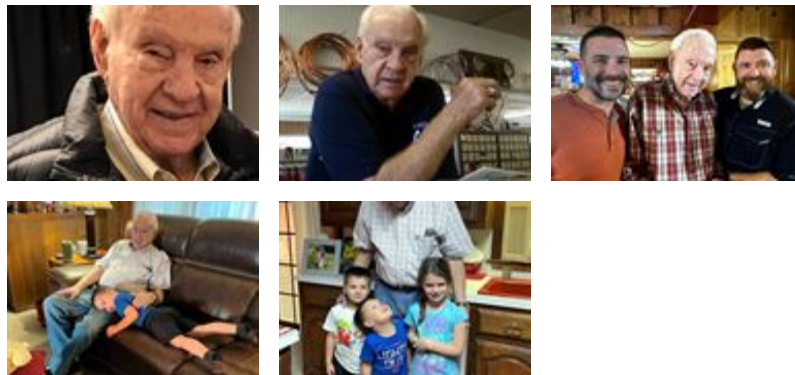
