



## Tommy Lee Thompson

August 30, 1942 - June 20, 2020

Tommy Lee Thompson, 77, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away at home surrounded by his family on Saturday, June 20, 2020, after a long battle with cancer. He was born August 30, 1942 in Stigler, Oklahoma to Lindon and Mary (Preskitt) Thompson. He attended Stigler Elementary and later moved with his family to Muskogee.
