Some knew her as Virginia but those closest to her knew her as Mom, Granny, and Genner. Some family activities were spent riding horses and going downtown only spending a quarter to watch a movie and eat dinner.

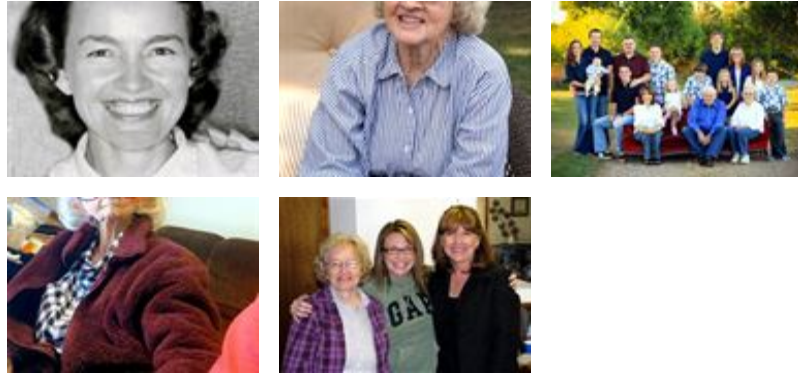
