Wendell Eual Cox, 88, of Webbers Falls, OK passed away on Monday, February 27, 2023. He was born on October 18, 1934 to Eual and Irene (Thomason) Cox in Webbers, Falls, OK. He attended public school, graduating from Webbers Falls High School. He furthered his education for a short time at Connors State College until enlisting in the United States Air Force. There he became a staff sergeant and served during the Korean War. Wendell worked as a US postal carrier until retiring in 2001. During this time, he was also an aerial crop duster pilot. He later became an ordained minister and started working as a hospice chaplain. All while holding several positions within his local community.

He married the love of his life, Regina Faye Stewart on September 1, 1960 in Webbers Falls, OK. They shared over 62 years of marriage and memories together.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Eual and Irene Cox; and brother, Glen Cox.
