William Thomas "Bill" Howerton, 65, of Warner, went peacefully to be with the Lord Monday, December 10, 2012 at Eastar Medical Center. He was also an M-14 rifle sharpshooter and an M-16 rifle expert. Bill served our country for 10 years before being honorably discharged in 1969.
