William Dale Robertson, 56, of Tahlequah, Oklahoma passed away Sunday, October 21, 2012 with his loving family at his side. He was born April 29, 1956 in Colorado Springs, Colorado to Ramon (Robbie) D. Robertson and Norma Gail Robertson. After high school, William furthered his education attending Oklahoma State University in Stillwater where he was a member of Phi Delta Theta Fraternity. He returned to Muskogee where he met and later married Sharon K. Scaper in 1977. Two sons were born to this union. William worked for Georgia Pacific for a span of 20 years. At the time of his death, William was employed by Healthcare Solutions in Muskogee as a Utilization Review Facilitator. He was a talented artist and a gifted musician.
