



## William G. "Bill" Webster

William George Webster was born February 22, 1932 in Ponca City, Oklahoma and was the only child of George and Alice Webster. Bill graduated from Ponca City High School with the class of 1950.

Bill joined the National Guard and served from 1945-1949. He then re-enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1950 and he was later transferred to the 1st U.S. Marine Division where he was trained as a Combat Corpsman. Bill was deployed to Korea from 1952-1954 and received an honorable discharge in 1955.

After coming back from Korea, Bill attended Lab and X-Ray School in Chicago, Illinois and worked in this field for many years. Later he went to work for Wyeth Lab as a pharmaceutical representative. He then went into selling health insurance until his retirement in 2003. Before and after his retirement, Bill had the honor of helping many veterans. One of his greatest pleasures was being able to help establish the Korean War Veterans Association in Muskogee.

Bill was a former member of the 1st Christian Church of Henryetta, Oklahoma. He was also a member of the DAV, VFW and American Legion Chapter 177. Bill enjoyed going camping and fishing. He loved his family very much and loved spending as much time with them as possible. Bill will be missed by everyone who knew and loved him.

He was preceded in death by his parents, George and Alice Webster; and a beloved brother-in-law, Thomas Berry, Jr.

Bill is survived by his loving wife and best friend, Judy; son, James;

daughters, Judy Jackson and Lesley Logan and husband Randy; granddaughters, Amber Wilson and Randa Beck; grandsons, Grant, Case and Drake; great-grandsons, Robert McFalls, Jr. and Cooper Beck; and many other family members and friends.
