William Howard Wilson, 83, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Wednesday, June 13, 2012 in Tulsa, Oklahoma with his loving daughter at his side. He was born October 22, 1928 in Muskogee to Henry Russell Wilson and Hazel Ruth Roe Wilson. Howard grew up in the Muskogee area graduating from Central High School in Muskogee. He joined the United States Army and served his country in the Korean War with the 45th Infantry Division until he was honorably discharged. Howard was later employed with Oklahoma Natural Gas from which he retired in 1986. Howard began courting Verba Mae Echols and she became his bride in September of 1957. They celebrated 50 wonderful years of marriage until her untimely death in 2008. Howard was an active member of Boulevard Christian Church in Muskogee for many years, significantly serving in many areas of ministry until the time of his death.
