



## Winfred "Peg" Ezra Fulton

September 23, 1926 - May 28, 2022

Winfred 'Peg' Ezra Fulton, 95, of Oktaha, OK passed away on Saturday, May 28th, 2022. He was born on September 23rd, 1926 to Jesse Monroe and Opal (Hines) Fulton in Alanreed, TX. His dad nicknamed him Winnipeg and it was soon shortened to Peg.

He and his older brother, Marlin, were raised around Alanreed, TX riding their goats, Whitey and Billy, all over the West Texas canyons. In 1938, they moved to Gladiola, NM where he helped his family farm and raise cattle and horses. He learned from his dad how to ride a horse, his love for cattle and the cowboy way of life. Peg passed this love on to the rest of his family as well. During World War II he enlisted in the US Navy at the age of 18 and was stationed in Norfolk, Virginia. He was always patriotic and loved his great country.

He married Patsy Houston in Pep, NM on September 28th, 1949. They moved to the Sunny Slope area south of Keefeton, OK in 1952 where they ran a dairy, raised beef cattle and their children. In 1971, Peg and Pat became Papaw and Mamaw and their house was always full of love and good times. He was preceded by his parents, Monroe and Opal; brother, Marlin Fulton and infant brother, Little Fulton; numerous cousins, in-laws, and friends; and best friend, Chuck Jordan.

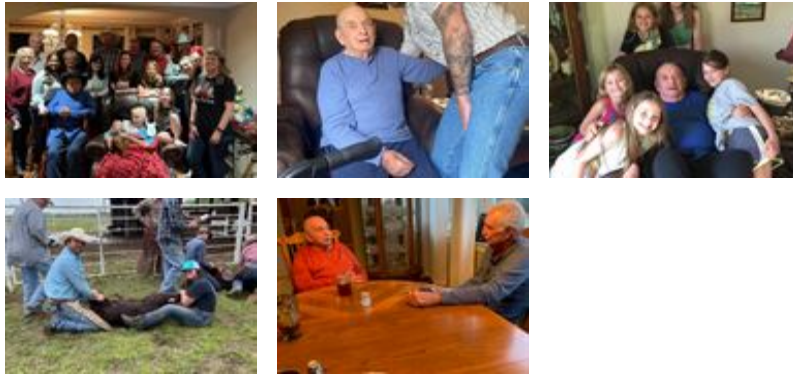

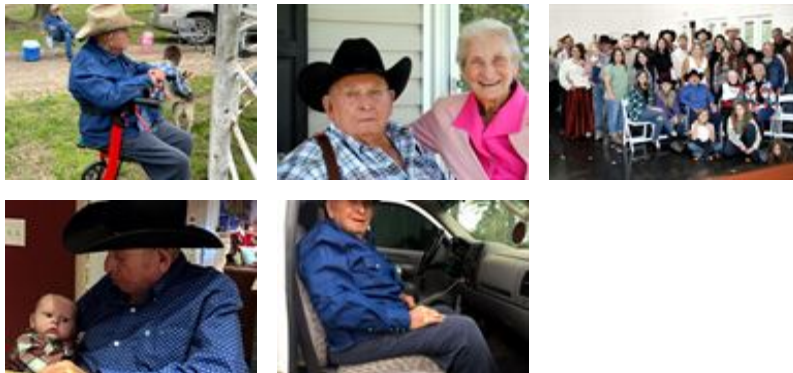
